July 12 – 16, 2004

CHES I. Modern Chess Principles

3-credit hours undergraduate course

Instructors – Grandmasters Yury Shulman and Alexander Onischuk, International Master John Donaldson

The course will give an understanding of evolution of chess concepts from classical chess players - from romantic style to first positional influence in XIX century; domination of positional play by first and second World Champions to Modern chess conceptions including harmony, universalism and intuition.

July 19-23, 2004

CHES II. Professional Chess Training

3-credit hours undergraduate course

Instructors – Grandmasters Yury Shulman and Alexander Onischuk, International Master John Donaldson

The course will explain comprehension of individual preparation by professional chess players. A team of professional chess player will teach conceptions of opening preparation, improvement of tactical vision, understanding of strategic ideas and endgame principles.
