



Summer Scholastic Chess Open

Saturday, July 17th 2004

At Claremore First Assembly of God

2100 W. Blue Starr Drive (1/3 mile West of Will Rogers Memorial on Blue Starr)

Type: 5 Round Swiss System, Everyone Plays 5 Games, School Team Sensitive (if matched pairings possible)

Sections (1) Grades K-6 U750 (under 750 USCF Rating), (2) Grades K-6 Open, (3) Grades 7-12 U1000, (4) Grades 7-12 Open. Sections 1 and 3 include new (unrated) players wanting to be rated by USCF. Sections are based on the 2003-2004 school year grade level.

Schedule: Registration/Check-In from 8-9 AM. Round 1 begins at 9:30 AM. You must check-in by 9 AM to play in Round 1, even if pre-registered. Section 1 is G/30 (game in max 30 minutes per player), and all other sections G/45. Expected finish before 4 PM for section 1 and by 6:30 PM for sections 2-4. Breakfast, lunch, and snack concessions are provided on site.

Awards: Individual trophies for top 3 individuals and top 2 teams in each section!! Medals will be awarded to all scoring at least 3 points! (out of 5 possible and not receiving a trophy) Awards will be presented as each section completes its final round. Top 4 finishers in the same section from the same school (same building or connected buildings) are combined for the team score (minimum 2 per team).

Entry Fee: \$15 if post marked by 12 July 2004 and \$25 on-site.

Please pre-register if possible to help get the tournament started on-time. (Proceeds will benefit students selected to compete at the National Fine Arts Festival for the Assemblies of God.) Make tournament registration **checks payable to First Assembly of God** and send to:

USCF: All players must have a current membership with the US Chess Federation. These memberships may be renewed or purchased during tournament check-in. Under age 14 is \$19 and youth under 20 is \$25. This is an Annual membership and will provide your player with a national rating and a quarterly magazine. Under age 14 membership without magazine is \$13. Make checks or money orders payable separately to USCF. Credit card may be used for USCF membership payments only.

Equipment: Players are encouraged to bring a chess clock if they have one.

Byes: Players must provide advance notice of not playing in up to two of rounds 1-4, receiving 1/2 point each.
