2 blocks East of Route 66 on Stuart Roosa (last traffic light on north side of town)

Type: Swiss System, Everyone Plays All Games, School Team Sensitive (if matched pairings possible)

Sections & Awards:

- (1) K-4 U500 (2) K-6 U700 (3) K-12 U900 (4) K-12 U1100

All sections above: 5 rounds G/45 (game in max 45 minutes per player). Team score = top 3 scores. Trophies for top 3 individuals & top 2 teams. Medals for 3 or more points.

(5) K-12 U1400. 4 Rounds G/60. Trophies for top 2 individuals & top team. Medals for 2.5 points+. Team score = top 2 scores.

(6) 1300+. 3 Rounds G/90, No teams. Trophies for top 2 individuals. Medals for 2 points+.

Tiebreaks: 1st individual trophies, 5-minute Blitz Playoff Double Match or Round Robin with coin toss for color. Otherwise standard USCF tiebreaks in USCF recommended order. Accelerated pairings may be used for larger sections to help avoid ties.

Schedule: Registration/Check-In from 8-9 AM. Round 1 begins at 9:30 AM.

You must check-in by 9 AM to play in Round 1, even if pre-registered.

Teams: Players from same school (connected buildings) are combined for team scores (min 2 per team).

Entry Fee: \$15 if post marked by 28 March 2005 and \$25 on-site.

\$15 refund for players rated 1400 and above who finish all rounds & submit valid score sheets.

Please pre-register if possible to help get the tournament started on-time.

USCF: All players must have a current membership with US Chess Federation. These memberships may be renewed or purchased during tournament check-in. Under age 14 is \$15. Under age 20 is \$21. Family plan is \$31 for all under age 20. This is an Annual membership and will provide your player with a national rating and bi-monthly magazine. Credit card may be used for USCF membership payments only.

Equipment: Players should bring a chess clock if possible. Boards & pieces provided for tournament games.

Byes: Players must provide advance notice of not playing in only one round, receiving 1/2 point.

Last round byes must be requested at tournament registration or check in.
