Directions: From I-35, turn west on West Tecumseh Road. Turn Right @ traffic light on 36th Ave, All Saints is on your right.

Type: K-12th grade, Swiss, school team sensitive, blitz playoff for 1st place ties, ½-point bye available except in last round.

Sections & Awards: Players may “play up” 100 points to higher rated section.

Onsite Registration: Players registering onsite may receive a bye in round 1. Onsite registration from 8:00 – 8:45am

Teams: Top four finishers from the same school in the same section combine for team score.

Pre-Registered: Pre-registered players must check-in 8:00-8:30am, after 9am may receive round 1 bye

Schedule: Round 1 begins 9am for Sections 5; 6. Round 1 begins 9:30am for Sections 1 - 4

Entry Fee: \$15.00 for Door registration and if mailed and post marked by Monday, **April 4, 2011.**

Door registrations may receive a ½-point bye for Round 1.

Teams:

1. Team Definition: All “school team” members must have their primary enrollment in the same school. No combined schools are allowed. A school is defined as the same building or connected buildings under the same name.
2. Home schooled players are allowed to form teams under the following guidelines to determine their school (team):
3. If the player is actively a part of a public or private school-based club, use the name of that school provided the student resides within that school's boundaries.
4. If the player is not practicing with any group, write 'home school'. The player is not officially on a team, but will compete for all individual awards.
5. If the player is practicing with a home school club including family-based clubs, this group is a team provided that the members all reside within the same congressional district. Use the name of the club on the line following 'school'. The team must be listed as an OSCO affiliate at www.okschess.org. OSCO affiliation is free and your club may be listed by providing name and contact information to OSCO.
6. Please contact your club director if you have any questions.
7. Team scores will be the total of top 4 scores in a section for players from the same team. There must be at least three players from the same school to qualify for a team award.
8. Coaches and Players must verify proper team affiliations on the wall charts before the beginning of round. Corrections to team affiliations must be made prior to the completion of the 1st round and should be checked at the beginning of the tournament for correct team sensitivity of pairings.

Rules:

1. Pairings will be team sensitive so long as proper pairings are possible.
2. The tournament will be run in accordance with the USCF Official Rules of Chess.
3. All players are responsible to put their scores on the scoring sheet before they leave the tournament room. If no score put in the score sheet for both players, then ½ points will be awarded to both players, regardless who won that game round.
4. If in doubt, players always confirm their game result with the judge before leaving the table and finishing the game.
5. The Chief Tournament Director will be the final authority regarding all rulings. TD retain right to make final decision for any conflict during the tournament.
6. Only Oklahoma Students are eligible for titles and trophies (medals for non-residents with plus score).
7. No byes in the last round and all byes must be requested before the end of the prior round.
8. Parents or guardians are responsible to keep their children in the assigned areas at All Saints Catholic School.
9. Outside food will not be allowed INSIDE the All Saints premises. The concession food will be available.
